We will be learning all about the geography of the United Kingdom by using atlases to study the countries, counties and cities as well as looking in detail at the human and physical features of many different places.



Our English work will centre around Legends of the United Kingdom including Robin Hood. We will be spending time examining characters and settings and writing our own legends.

We will also study places of interest in the British Isles and create presentations to persuade visitors to go there.

In maths we are going to be working hard on all aspects of number including place value, addition and subtraction. We will also work on statistics where we will read and interpret graphs and timetables.

In history we will study Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and look at important events in the Anglo-Saxon period.
