YEAR 1 PHONICS INVITATION



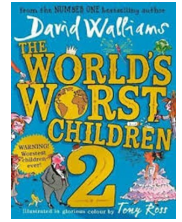
Many thanks to all the family members who attended Mrs Pullen's Phonics lesson this week.
