

Year One Home Learning Opportunities

Literacy

In Literacy we are going to be looking at extending our sentences and spellings.

- Sing the days of the week song.
- Write the days of the week on pieces of paper (making sure they are spelled correctly). Now mix up the papers and see if you put them in the correct order.
- Write a plan for your week using the following stem sentences 'On Monday I will...'.
e.g. On Monday I will tidy my bedroom **because I am a Healthy Hero.**

Continue to practising spelling our Year 1 common exceptions words and reading our Phase 4 and 5 tricky words.

Maths

In maths we are going to continue counting in 2s, 5s and 10s as well as looking at place value and representing numbers in tens and ones.

Things you can do to support this learning at home include:

- Write and say your 2s, 5s and 10s times tables ($1 \times 2 = 2$).
- Chop up your times tables and then time yourself putting them back in the correct order.
- Choose a number up to 50 and represent it by drawing Base 10.
- Choose 3 numbers up to 50 and put them in the right order (lowest to greatest).
- Choose 3 numbers and put them in the right order (greatest to lowest).

Topic

In topic we are going to be thinking about Easter and Spring.

Things you can do to support this learning at home include:

- Design a box for an Easter egg.
- Use the internet to research and write a list of things that happen in Spring.
- Sketch/paint/collage a bunch of Spring flowers.
- Write a list of farm animals and find out what their babies are called e.g. A baby horse is called a foal.
