- Playing movement games with a family member. Blindfold a member of your family then instruct them how to get to a finishing point using the words: forwards, backwards, left and right.

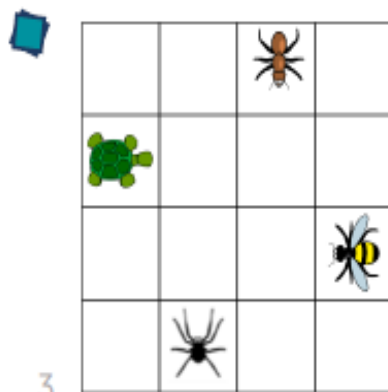
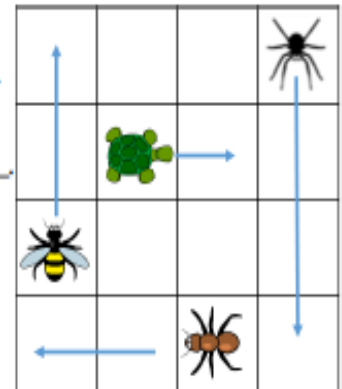
Complete the stem sentences to describe the movements made.
