Can you congratulate other players if they score more points than you?

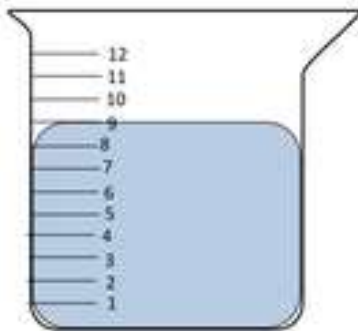
