Return to full opening of school

Dear families

We are delighted that all the children will be able to return to school from Monday 8th March. The government expects **all** children to be in school and teachers are looking forward to welcoming back all members of their classes.

We have a comprehensive risk assessment in place to protect all children and adults in school. We will continue to work in bubbles and hand washing / sanitising will still be an essential part of the school day. All adults will wear face masks when they aren't in classrooms and we still expect parents to wear masks when they enter the school yard.

We will continue to welcome children into school between 8.30 and 8.50am to reduce congestion in the morning, and will also continue to have a staggered end to the day. Any children in downstairs classrooms (Reception to Year 3) can be collected between 3pm and 3.15pm. Year 4 children will be brought down to the yard at 3.05pm, Year 5 at 3.10pm and Year 6 at 3.15pm. Please wait outside the school grounds at a safe distance until your child is brought out.

We still have a one-way system in place on the yard. If you have a child in a downstairs classroom and one in an upstairs room, please wait until the oldest one is brought down, then come into the yard to collect them, then go and collect the younger child from their classroom.

Children all need to come to school in their uniforms and bring a water bottle with them. The school kitchens will run as normal, so children who normally have school dinners will still receive them.

We look forward to seeing everyone again on Monday!
